- Read Psalm 71: 1 8

Psalm 71:1-8 gives us reasons why we can have certain hope in God when the world gives us reasons to mourn.

O Lord, I have come to You for <u>protection</u>; don't let me be disgraced. <u>Save me</u> and <u>rescue me</u>, for You <u>do what is right</u>. Turn your ear to <u>listen to me</u>, and <u>set me free</u>. Be my <u>rock of safety</u> where I can always hide. Give the order to save me, for You are my rock and my fortress My God, rescue me from the power of the wicked, from the clutches of cruel oppressors. O Lord, You alone are my hope. I've trusted You, O Lord, from childhood. Yes, You have been with me from birth; from my mother's womb You have cared for me. No wonder I am always praising you! My life is an example to many, because

you have been my strength and protection. That is why I can never stop praising you; I declare your glory all day long.
