The byline to our new sermon/Life Group series called '**DEVOTED**' states how we are "building a community to reach a community."

The word used in the original language of the New Testament is, 'koinonia' which means sharing, partnership, and community.

**Church Renewal** will also seek to lead us in building a strong community of believers. Recently some of our elders, along with their spouses, were able to attend a Church Renewal weekend with Glenda and I in Steinbach, Manitoba. With our leaders being introduced to Church Renewal, we are better equipped to move forward with more surety into the process of renewing our church.

We were also grateful to host a **Church Renewal Roundtable** here at The Gate with Pastor Ray Duerksen. I am told this was the largest gathering of pastors and leaders in one place for our region in at least 20 years. God is on the move in the Niagara region! Praise God!

We are beginning the renewal process with *prayer*. Sunday morning "Prayer Start" will eventually lead to an after service prayer time where we will have people of prayer available to follow up with those who desire prayer.

It's been a few months since my last update. During that time, we have been working hard on improvements, and upgrades to our building. Rental turnovers within the Gate space have created several opportunities for enhancements to electrical and plumbing services to those



temporarily vacant spaces. Hopefully these improvements will make theses spaces more attractive to prospective tenants.

We completed a lighting upgrade to the front of the building. There is a LED flood light illuminating the "GATE" logo. All front entrance lighting (Church & Valley Way), as well as driveway lighting, have been upgraded to LED. This makes the front of our building much brighter, and more energy efficient.
